Each day a CCA kindergartener will learn phonetic rules in order to read fluently; practice addition 00+and subtraction facts and their families; read and listen to stories, poems, and songs that captivate their attention and imaginations; and explore topics in science and social studies. With over 80 picture, poem, and story books read aloud over the course of a year, students will come home with a story to tell and a craft to display.

PHONICS/READING/LANGUAGE

- Recognition of all consonants, vowels, and sounds
- 45 common (sight) words
